The Coral Gables High School PTSA is pleased to announce the **Teacher Mini Grant Program 2025-26!** Projects funded by Mini Grants should aim to enhance the learning environment at CGHS. Most Mini Grants awarded by the PTSA are less than \$1,000. However, if you have a request that exceeds \$1,000, we welcome your grant submission.

Applications will be accepted until midnight October 15, 2025. Approval will be announced no later than November 1, 2025.

- Completed applications must be submitted to the Teacher Mini Grant Chair via email at dopico@bellsouth.net
- Teachers <u>must be current PTSA members</u> to qualify for a Mini Grant. PTSA memberships can be renewed at the following link: https://gablesptsa.memberhub.com/store/items/33013
- Applications are reviewed and approved by the PTSA Board.
- Teacher Mini Grants may be approved for the full amount requested, or a partial amount.
- Once approved, funding for approved Mini Grant projects may occur in one of two ways:
 - a) Teachers can submit a quote to the PTSA, and the PTSA will purchase the item(s)
 - b) Teachers may purchase the items themselves and receive a reimbursement up to the granted amount based upon the receipts submitted to the PTSA
- All reimbursements or purchases must be completed by the end of the 2025-26 school year.
- Deadline to apply is October 15, 2025 at midnight
